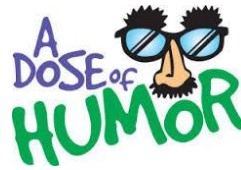

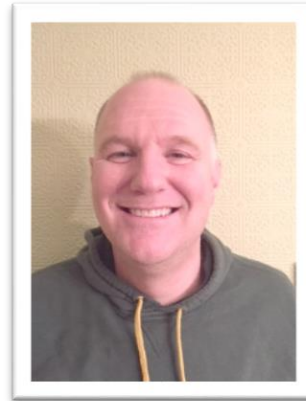


### **PRESIDENT**

profession is in financial planning. I enjoy golfing, fishing, watching football and being with my family.



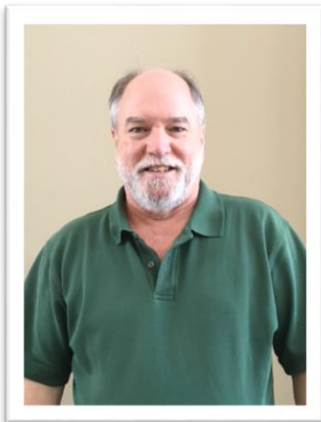
### **FINANCE**

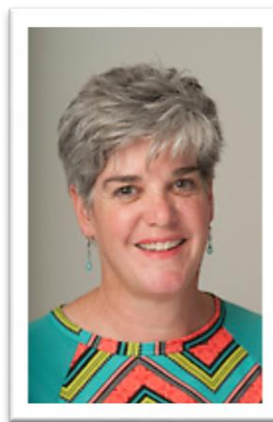


**PROPERTY**

**NON-BUDGET EXPLANATION**

Answer to the question regarding the 2015 Non-budget expense line item being so high.

This line item includes all non-budget expenses, but also includes expenses that are pass through items. For example, Monies brought in for Easter flowers go into the General fund, and when we pay for the flowers it goes under the non-budget line item as an expense. Also, when we need to transfer money from our Associated bank Capital Fund and send to Mission Investment Capital account, the funds are transferred to the General Fund and then expensed through the Non-Budget line item.
