From the Desk of Pastor Sandy

Greetings brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we greet the new month of March, we are entering the new church season of Lent. The rhythm and rhyme of the season call us to practice and prepare. Over the course of the coming six weeks we will prepare our hearts and minds for the ways we are called by God in Christ Jesus to live in the world. And during the Lenten season we are even more intentional as we pray, share, and fast.

With that intentionality in mind, mark your calendars for a time of fellowship, food and worship. Midweek worship services will begin on *Ash Wednesday, March 6*. Soup and sandwiches will be served from 6:00 – 6:45 and our worship will be at 7:00.

March 13, 20, 27, April 3 and 10 are the additional midweek dates when we will gather in preparation for the upcoming Holy Week and Easter Sunday, *April 14-21*. These midweek evening worship services are the place and time for us to practice our prayers, our sharing, and even our fasting.

Lent is a season of preparation and practice and as I often say, "practice makes better."

Fasting can be reexamined by abstaining from things other than food. Perhaps you'll consider the practice of fasting from social media for a day – *ok*, *for a few hours*; or fasting from thinking negatively of others; or fasting from desserts; or fasting from television/Netflix...what might you consider leaving behind for this time of intentional preparation?

Time for praying and sharing can be created by the fasting to which you commit. Prayers abound for the life of this community of faith, Mt. Zion, as well as for the wider community within which we all find ourselves living out our faith. Prayers of praise and thanksgiving, as well as prayers of intercession keep us connected to God. May we practice our prayers with renewed intention during the season of Lent.

As people of faith we are called to share as well. This Lenten season we have an opportunity to address the challenge of hunger around the world as we participate through the ELCA Global Barnyard, teaming with other congregations in the St. Croix conference to really make a difference. In my brief history with you I've already come to know the people of Mt. Zion as a people who practice generosity.

May we all be intentional as we gather together for our Lenten journey. May we support and encourage one another in these practices as the Spirit guides our praying, sharing and fasting. It is in these practices that we experience what God is up to in our lives, in the church and in the world.

Thanks be to God for you.
