Students need to have completed their freshman year before signing up for the trip.

There is a Mishpack kick off meeting typically the end of February or beginning of March. Students are required to attend pre-trip training sessions called Mishpack University.

Students are required to complete 24 hours of service projects before the Mission Trip.

Mishpack already owns a lot of the equipment for both weeks so students and their parents don't need to worry about buying a lot for the trip.

## MIDDLE SCHOOL

Middle School NETworks is for all students 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade.

During the fall and spring, the youth meet at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Hudson. During the winter they meet at Mt. Zion Lutheran Church

Middle School NETworks meets on Wednesdays from 3:00 -4:45 pm.

Students are picked up at the north end of the Hudson Middle School the NETworks bus. Students are bused to either St. Paul's or Mt. Zion. Parents can pick up their youth at 4:45.

A typical Wednesday starts off with a snack provided by one of the students (or their parents). The afternoon continues with singing worship, a message, small groups and time to hang out.



## SENIOR HIGH

Senior High NETworks is for all students 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade.

It meets at First Baptist's Crossing Point (220 Vine St. in Hudson.)

Doors open at 5:15 pm, final prayer is at 8:30 pm and doors close at 9:00 pm

A typical Wednesday has most students coming between 5:15 pm and 6:00 pm to just relax and hang out until supper. Some of them do homework during this time, but other activities are board games, video games, ping pong, and socializing.

Evening worship begins at 7:00 pm with a time of worship music led by our Networks youth worship team.

This is followed by a message and small groups and we close out the night with final group prayer at 8:30.

The students are then free to hangout and play games until 9:00.
